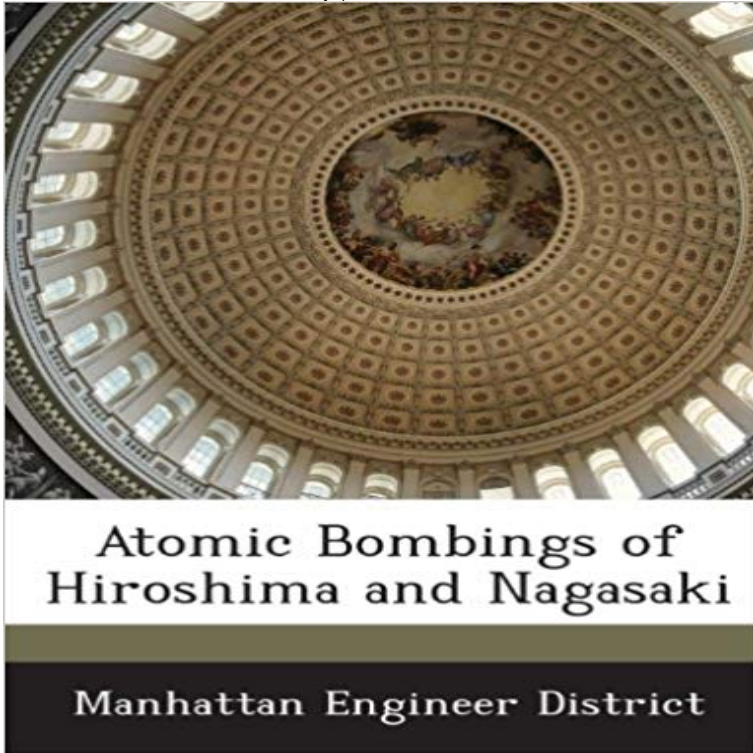


# Atomic Bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki
